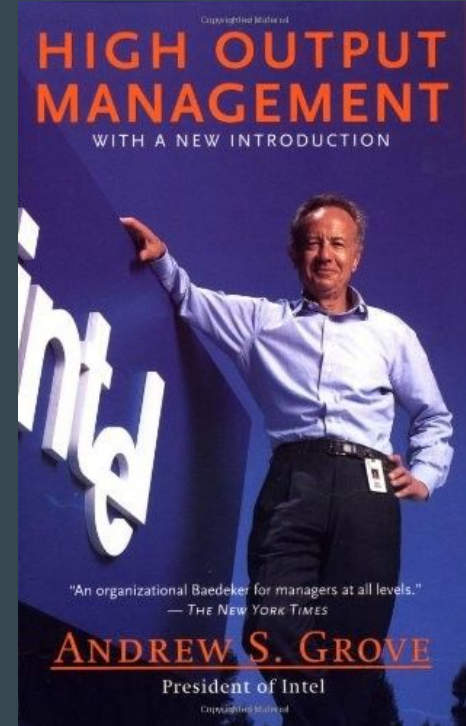

High Output Management

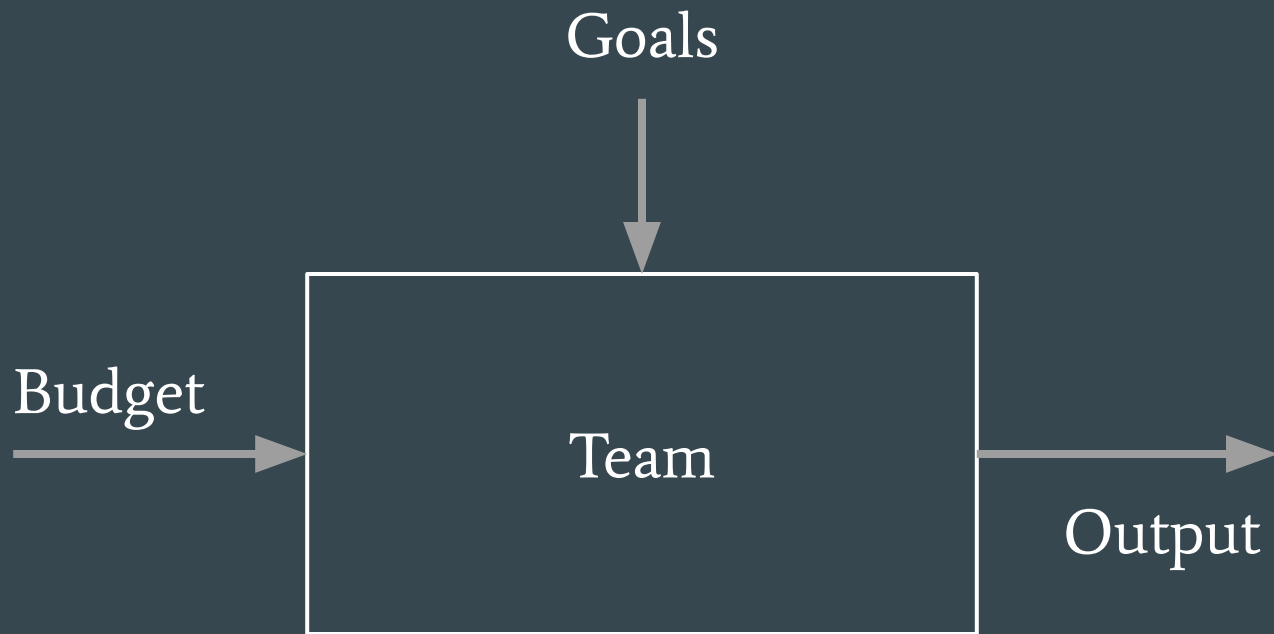
“A manager’s output =

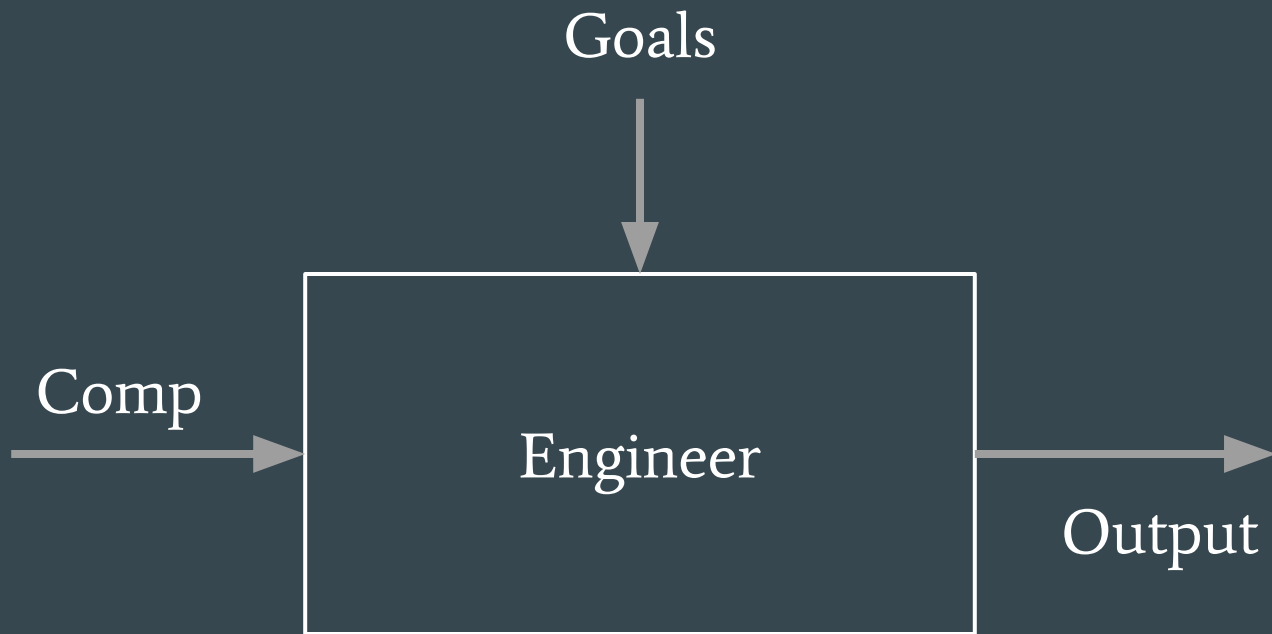
the output of his organization +

High Oversight	Development	Micromanaging
